

Emmanuel N. Haniah New York Testimony

The young man in this picture was recruited by an organized crime member in New York City 1990. At the age of 20, Emmanuel Haniah was leading men into a dark, evil, and violent world of crime. Emmanuel's job was to recruit and train men to protect the black market underworld and establishments. These included brothels, topless bars, and nightclubs throughout New York City. The black market was a multi-million dollar organization, bringing in hundreds of thousands, sometimes even millions, on a weekly basis. Emmanuel and his crew were paid well to be the muscle and protection for the underworld boss's best interest. By pure brute force, guns, and violence, Emmanuel and his crew did whatever it took to please their boss and protect the money.
